THE INTERNATIONAL OBLIGATIONS
(ECONOMIC AND ANCILLARY MEASURES)
(COTE D'IVOIRE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2008

The Governor-General, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Act, makes the following Order -

Citation. 1. This Order which amends the International S.I. No.59 Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Cote d'Ivoire) of 2005. Order, 2005 may be cited as the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) (Cote d'Ivoire) (Amendment) Order, 2008.
