The Embassy of the Republic of Korea presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas and has the honor to inform the latter that the National Institute for International Education (NIIED) under the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Korea will invite one (1) national of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas for the “2018 Global Korea Scholarship: Korean Government Scholarship Program for International Students for Graduate Degree” (hereafter called “2018 Graduate GKS”) to be conducted in Korea for the academic year 2018~2020.

To this end, the Embassy plans to recommend two (2) qualified candidates to the NIIED which will make a final choice among the two. After confirmed by the NIIED, the successful candidates are expected to arrive in Korea in August 2018.

Applicants should submit all required documents/forms to the Embassy no later than March 23, 2018 and interviews will be held in due course with a limited number of applicants who have met the application deadline and passed through the documentation review. It is kindly noted that those who fail to meet one of the qualifications set forth in the Application Guideline will be automatically disqualified.
