

Seaman's Visa are issued to crew members of boats temporarily visiting The Bahamas for the purpose of trade or employees of cruise ships that are registered vessels of The Bahamas.

Supporting Documents required (single entry or multiple entry) for Seaman's Visa:

Scanned digital copies of the following current (i.e. less than 6 months old) photo and supporting documents are required to be appended to your application:

- 1 digital passport photo in jpg format (see [Bahamas eVISA Photograph Specifications](#))

**In PDF format:**

- Filled & signed application form
- Data page of your passport (personal data and signature pages) ([click here to see sample](#))
- Police Report \* (**less than 6 months old**)
- Medical Certificate (**less than 6 months old**)
- Copies of previous BAHAMAS Visas if visited The Bahamas before (**at least 3 are required for multiple entry consideration**).
- Ship or Boat registration
- Proof of Ship or Boat ownership
- Temporary cruising permit issued by Bahamas Customs
- Dockage fees from Bahamas Port Department
