The program aims to promote the development of digital talents to develop their skills and strengthen their competitiveness, reducing the digital gap in the region, especially in the most vulnerable groups on this digital, also encouraging a gender equity among the candidates. The selected students will be able to be trained in one of the most advanced digital technologies.

### **Participation Requirements:**

- Be of the nationality of the applicant country
- Be between 18 & 45 years old
- Be a university student or university graduate
- Intermediate or advanced English speaking language (Mandatory)

- *Curriculum Vitae*
- *Motivation letter*
- *English level proof (Diploma)*

### ***Course program***

- *6 months*

### ***Applicant recommendations:***

By accepting the program, the participant agrees to dedicate a minimum of weekly study time to fully complete the program following the specified time.

The selected candidate also committed to share his progress and to maintain a fluid communication with the program organization.

The organizers may suspend the participants who do not respect with the terms and conditions of the program.

### ¿How to apply?

Candidates must be nominated by the Secretaries or Ministries of Foreign Affairs of the Community of Latin American and the Caribbean states (CELAC). Each country must nominate a minimum of 50 candidates and up to 100 candidates. Eligible students must submit their complete documentation:

- Be of the nationality of the applicant country and be between 18 & 45 years old  
(You must send an identification document)
- Be a university student or university graduate  
(You must send your University Diploma or a certification note from the University)
- Intermediate or advanced English speaking language (Mandatory)  
(You must send a High School diploma or a English language certification note)
- Also need to include your **Curriculum Vitae** and a **Motivation letter** (1 page)

Each country must send to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Honduras, no later than August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024, his **OFFICIAL CANDIDATES LIST** to participate in the training program “**ICT Talent for Digital development of Latin America and the Caribbean**” in September 2024. The candidate’s profiles will be reviewed and they will be contacted to confirm their participation in the program. Selected candidates must follow up the following steps:

Step 1- Register on the platform (*Selected candidates will receive in their e-mail a web link to register their account int the Huawei platform.*)

Step 2- A registration confirmation from the Huawei platform will arrive in the candidate’s email. He must check his e-mail and click into the link to complete the registration.

Step 3- Log in in the education platform, select the courses and start the training modules. (At the end of the first period, the courses of the second period will be available.

Step 4- At the end of each module, you will receive the course certificate, which you can view and download from your profile. In addition, students will be able to contact a person in charge of the program to answer any question.
